- THE COURT'S JULY 16, 2021 GENERAL ORDER REGARDING COURT MANDATED PROCEDURES FOR ENTRY INTO THE COURT FACILITY IS HEREBY MODIFIED AS SET FORTH IN THIS ORDER.
- ALL PERSONS WHO ARE SICK, SHALL NOT COME TO THE COURT. Any person who is sick or who is exhibiting COVID-19 symptoms will be denied entry for that day.
- FOR INDIVIDUALS APPEARING IN ANY AREAS OF THE COURT FACILITY, THE USE OF MASKS IS RECOMMENDED AND ENCOURAGED, BUT NO LONGER REQUIRED.
- ALL JUDICIAL OFFICERS OF THE SUPERIOR COURT CONTINUE TO HAVE THE AUTHORITY TO ORDER ANY INDIVIUDAL TO WEAR A MASK WHILE IN ANY AREA OF THE COURT FACILITY.
